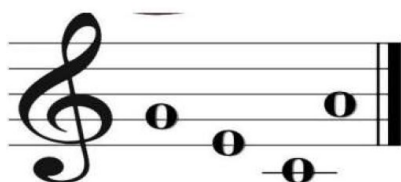
A chord is when you play more than one note at the same time. (recap year 3)
