Year 3 Overnight Camp Experience - Monday 1st June – Tuesday 2nd June

We are pleased to offer all children in **Year 3** the opportunity to take part in an **overnight camp on the school field**.

During the experience, children will participate in a range of activities led by *The Outdoors People*, including **bushcraft, campcraft, life skills and games**. These activities are designed to develop **communication, cooperation, independence, leadership and listening skills**.

Why this experience is important

This camp provides a valuable introduction to overnight trips and helps prepare children for larger residential visits in **Years 4, 5 and 6**. As the camp takes place on the school site, children can feel reassured knowing that home and parents are nearby. Even very reluctant children have historically thrived and often look back on this experience with great pride.

Camp arrangements

- Children will sleep in **large tents**, accommodating approximately **8 children per tent**.
- All children will camp **together overnight on Monday 1st June**.
- The year group will be split into two groups for activities.
- When children are not participating in camp activities, they will attend **normal classroom lessons**.

Clothing and attendance

- Children should come to school on **Monday 1st June** wearing **comfortable clothing suitable for camping**.
- **No school uniform** is required on Monday or Tuesday.
- Children will be **collected from school at 3:30pm on Tuesday 2nd June**, as normal.

If your child attends an after-school club on **Monday 1st June**, please inform the school office to register their absence. Children may be very tired on **Tuesday 2nd June**, so we also recommend registering absence for any clubs that day.

Food arrangements

Monday 1st June

- Children will have their **normal school lunch or packed lunch**.
- Please provide:
 - A **healthy snack**
 - A **water bottle**
(Dinner will not be served until after 5:00pm.)
- A **hot evening meal** will be provided.
- All **dietary requirements and allergies** will be catered for. Please inform your class teacher of any allergies not already known.

Tuesday 2nd June

- School will provide a **light breakfast**.
 - Please provide a **healthy break-time snack**.
 - Lunch arrangements:
 - Children who normally have a **school lunch** will eat as usual.
 - Children who normally bring a **packed lunch** may either:
 - Have a **free school lunch**, or
 - Bring a packed lunch to the school office (clearly labelled with name and class).

Cost and payment

The total cost of the experience is **£70.00**, which covers:

- Tents
- Food
(*Sleeping bags are not included and must be provided by families.*)

Under the **Education Act 1996**, the cost must be met through **voluntary contributions**. The trip can only go ahead if sufficient contributions are received. Please note that **childcare or tax-free vouchers cannot be used** for this trip.

Pupil Premium Passport

If your child has a **Pupil Premium Passport**, the cost of the trip will be covered by the school.

What to bring

All items must fit into **one named rucksack**, which your child must carry themselves.

Essential items

- Water bottle
- Sleeping bag
- Pillow
- Torch
- Blanket
- Warm nightwear and layers (it has been very cold in previous years)
- Casual clothes for activities
- Spare clothes and underwear
- Trainers
- Sunhat and sunscreen
- Toothbrush, toothpaste and small face towel
- Plastic bag for dirty/wet clothes
- One small comfort item (teddy or blanket)
- Any required medication*
- Healthy snack for after school on **Monday** and morning break on **Tuesday**

*Medication must be clearly labelled and handed in according to school policy.

If your child is not dry overnight, please include **pull-ups and extra pyjamas**.

If rain is forecast, children should also bring **wellington boots and a waterproof coat**.

Do not bring

- Roll mats (these are provided)
 - Money
 - Phones, tablets or electronic devices
 - Electronic games
 - Sweets or sugary drinks
(*A snack will be provided around the campfire on Thursday evening.*)
