Key concepts covered: Find out and describe how plants need water, light and a suitable temperature to grow and stay healthy.

Key vocabulary

Plant – a living thing that usually grows in soil.

Flower – the part of a plant that blooms

Fruit – a part of a plant that contains seeds.

Vegetable – a part of a plant that can be eaten as food, such as a stem, root or leaf.

Herb – a plant that can be used to flavour food.
