Home Learning

This year, children will be given both spellings linked to the pattern taught that week and a selection of specific curriculum spellings. These words will then be used in a short dictation during the following week. These words can be found on the Year 2 Notice board [here](#). Times tables Rockstars should also be used to help learn multiplication facts. Pupils will also receive NumBots logins. It is advised that they practise for 3-5 minutes 4-5 times a week. Children will also need to read 5 times per week.

Whole class reading

In Year 2, our focus will continue to be decoding using Phonics for some pupils. However, the majority of pupils will start whole class guided reading. Like KS2, families will be asked to buy a copy of three books over the year. Pupils with a Pupil Premium Passport will be provided with a book from school. Please see the website for the books to be purchased.

Reading Records

Children will be coming home with reading books and a new Fielding Reading Record. Children should read to an adult daily; the adult should sign the reading record to say this has been completed and add a comment if necessary. The teacher will take the record in once a week to check and sign. These should be brought into school daily. You can find the Year 2 recommended reading list in the Reading Record. Your child can receive a bronze, silver or gold certificate for reading 5, 10 or 15 books from this list and completing a reading response activity (these can be found on the Year 2 page on the website). Children will also be required to borrow two school reading books (including one from the recommended reading list) and must be returned once completed. In addition, teachers will be reading to the class during 'story time' every day throughout the year. The books will either be the current books from English lessons or from the recommended reading list.

Book bags

Due to limited peg space to store children's personal belongings, please limit the number of additional items that are brought in. A backpack is not necessary as all required items can fit into the school book bag. Musical instruments and other items can be stored centrally.

Snack boxes and water

Fruit is provided daily during Morning break times. Please ensure that your child has a named water bottle in school every day. They can also bring in an extra healthy snack.
