Year 6 Trip to The Museum of Water and Steam

Dear Parents/Carers,

On Wednesday 26th and Thursday 27th of November 2025, Year 6 children will be visiting the Museum of Water and Steam in Kew to deepen their understanding following their Autumn 1 FLCC challenge of 'Steaming Ahead: How did the Victorian Era Shape Modern Britain?' On this trip, pupils will have the chance to investigate how transport has changed throughout history, and will get the chance to handle some museum objects.

6S and 6F will be visiting on Wednesday 26th November.
6P and 6H will be visiting on Thursday 27th November.

We will travel by public transport accompanied by staff and parent helpers. We will leave school at 9:15am and we expect to arrive back at school before 3pm. Children will need to wear full school uniform with a raincoat (weather depending). *Children will need a packed lunch for the day. We will not be providing a school packed lunch for your child unless you email the admin office at least 5 days before the trip to let us know your child would like one.*

Under the terms of the Education Act 1996, the cost of this visit must be met by voluntary contributions. The cost to attend this is **£8.00** per pupil. To provide your consent and pay the fee, please log into your MCAS account and select the 'Trips' icon by **Friday 21st November**. Please note, in accordance with HMRC regulations, we cannot accept childcare vouchers/tax free childcare as payment towards this trip. This trip is also not covered by the Pupil Premium Passport.

In order for this trip to go ahead, we will require the support of some parent helpers. Please let your child's class teacher know if you are able to accompany us on the relevant day.
